#### 1. Now This MOU Witnessed as Under:

- P. Rami Reddy Memorial College of Pharmacy is required to provide necessary entry and exist permissions included, but not restricted to gate-pass, other access

formalities to use its space for loading of recyclable and man power movement during the time of pickup.

#### 3. Indemnity:

#### Term:

The Agreement may be extended for such further periods and quantities as may be agreed to by the parties

Amendment: Any Amendment to this agreement shall be valid and binding on the parties only if it is made in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of each party
