- ✓ Replace incandescent lights with CFLs or LEDs whenever possible.
- ✓ When a meeting, lesson, or lecture is over, please turn off the lights and fans. Don't bother with any fancy lighting effects.
- ✓ Only turn on the fans when absolutely necessary.
- ✓ Water heaters in hostels are typically powered by renewable energy sources.
- ✓ Use public transport, and pedestrian-friendly roadways, we want to decrease local air pollution emissions and launch a tree-planting programme.
- ✓ To promote the adoption of cutting-edge technologies for the reduction of carbon footprints, air pollution, and noise pollution.

The Institute uses the three R's (Reduce, Recycle, and Reuse) to deal with waste: Reduce, Recycle, and Reuse. Here are some examples of projects:

- Turn on the power management tools on your computer and monitor so that when you're not using them, they go into a low-power "sleep" mode.
- ii. When you leave your table, turn off your screen.
- iii. Turn on your laser printer's power management tools.
- iv. If you can, shut down instead of signing off.
- v. Turn off lights you don't need and let the sun shine in instead.

- ix. Only use the fans when you need to.
